Enrollment of New Students

Greer Middle College is a public charter school that is authorized by Greenville County Schools. Admission to the school is open to all students who reside in Greenville County and there is no tuition charged since we are a public high school supported by state and local funding.

Our school typically enrolls approximately 100 new freshman students each year. Openings in other grades are on an as available basis, but returning students in good standing are guaranteed placement for those grades. If there are more than 100 applicants after the initial open enrollment period has ended, a lottery will take place to determine which students will be admitted to the next year's freshman class. Based on the lottery, a waiting list is also created if other students elect not to attend Greer Middle College.

Our school offers a unique learning experience on a college campus for high school students. We provide a strong core academic program that is enhanced by extensive higher education opportunities. All students at GMC have a personalized academic plan based upon their individual interests, talents and abilities. The school allows every student to pursue career pathways for a seamless transition to college or work while earning a high school diploma or college credit.

Participants will be able to tour the school and discuss academic opportunities with teachers, students and administrators.
